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The choice of Chuukese vocabulary in this book depends on author's own dialect and preference.  
The Chuukese spelling in this book conforms to the decisions of the Chuukese Orthography Conference,  
with one major exception. As per Chuuk State DOE practice and wish, word-initial doubled consonants are  
not indicated in spelling and are represented by single instead of double letters. For example, the word for  
sand, "ppil" is spelled "pil" even though the first sound is pronounced as doubled.



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
